

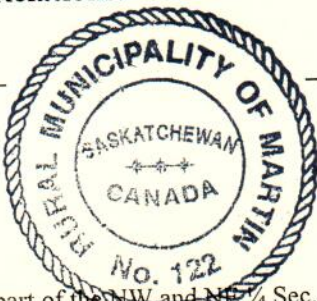
THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MARTIN NO. 122

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLANNING BYLAW No. 172/07

The Council of the RM of Martin No. 122, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw 172/07 as follows:

1. Section 4.3.4 Sand and Gravel is amended by repealing part i) and replacing it with the following:
  - i) 400 meters from any residence;
2. Section 5.3.3 Subdivisions for Medium Density Non-Farm Residential Clusters is amended by repealing part v) and replacing it with the following:
  - v) Where a proposed residential subdivision is located within 800 meters of the boundary of an Environmentally Sensitive Overlay District, Council may require the applicant to submit sufficient topographic or other information.
3. Section 5.3.3 Subdivisions for Medium Density Non-Farm Residential Clusters is amended by repealing part vi) and replacing it with the following:
  - vi) The minimum size of the remnant of a Quarter Section after the subdivision of any proposed cluster shall be 32.31 ha (80 acres) or the rezoning shall be refused by Council.
4. The Land Use Concept Map which is attached to and forms part of the Official Community Plan is amended by changing the land use policy from Agricultural to Country Residential on part of the NW and NE ¼ Sec. 1 Twp. 13 Rge. 32 W1M as outlined in bold dashed lines on the map below.
5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when it has been approved by the Minister of Government Relations.

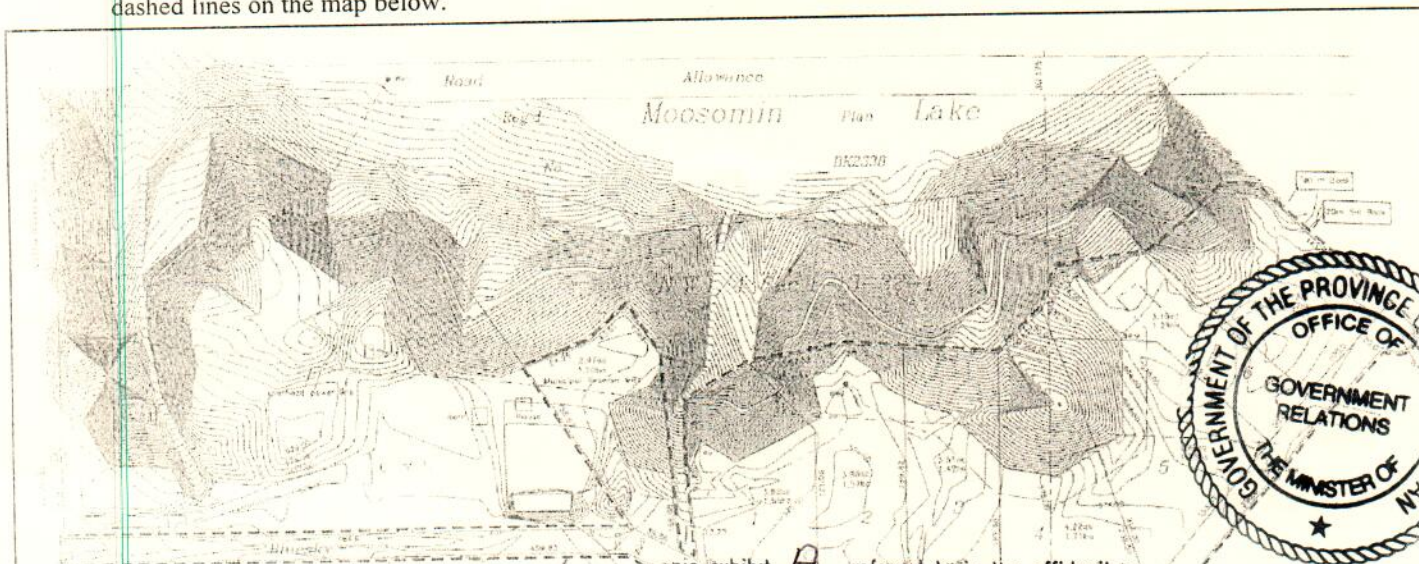

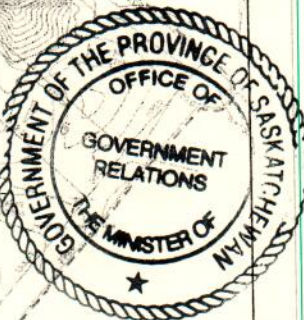
