

**2012** - Insurance was increased on the workshop to \$125,000 contents \$60,000 and storage shop \$50,000. The council gave support to STARS Air Ambulance. Range/township road signs were to be ordered as a municipal centennial project. S. Wilson did road construction on 4.5 km. of Grid #709 west of the Pipestone Bridge. Lots of time and work spent on the 57 PDAP sites from last years ' water issues.

**2013** – (Jan-May) Plans were made for an afternoon program and supper to be held at Wapella Hockey Arena and Sports grounds June 15, 2013. In the process of succession planning, Darcy Jamieson accepted the Foreman position in preparation of Tony Punko considering working less hours as he focuses on his greenhouse enterprise and future retirement. A second set of grader packers purchased. Also a second tractor and mower purchased so that mowing can continue while other road projects are being done. New census for R.M. population of 333. Property assessments were revalued this year. Currently the assessment has not been confirmed yet but is expected to be 89,907,398 with a municipal mill rate of 8.5 mills. Education mill rate at 2.67 mills on Agriculture assessment.
