

**BYLAW NO. 216 / 17**


**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MARTIN NO 122**

**A BYLAW TO LICENSE THE DRILLING OF OIL AND GAS WELLS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Martin No 122 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. For the purpose of this bylaw:
  - a. "Contractor" shall include any person, firm or corporation;
  - b. "Drilling" shall mean drilling of any kind for the purposes of oil or gas; and
  - c. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Martin No. 122
  
2. Any contractor undertaking drilling in the municipality shall pay to the municipality the following license fee:
  - a. for the drilling of an oil well or gas well \$450.00
  
  - b. for the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information \$225.00
  
3. Bylaw No. 134/91 is hereby repealed.
