BYLAW NO. 185/11

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MARTIN NO. 122

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality Of Martin No. 122 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Martin No. 122.
- 2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services from any service provider, if billed to the municipality shall be paid to the service provider by the municipality. The Administrator shall then charge costs as incurred by the municipality, directly on the persons who received the service.
- 3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year or 60 days after the person has been invoiced for the said services, whichever is earlier.
