

BYLAW NO. 223 / 19

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MARTIN NO 122 A BYLAW TO PROVIDE SNOW RIDGES AND SNOW FENCES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Martin No 122, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. The Council is hereby authorized to enter upon land adjoining any road allowance or other public highway for the purpose of making snow ridges or erecting snow fences as a measure to prevent the blocking of roads by snow drifts during winter months;
- 2. The person or persons authorized by Council to perform the work as herein provided shall have the right to entry on private property for such purposes only;
- 3. Any person who obstructs or interferes with an agent or servant of the Municipality engaged in carrying out the provisions of a resolution passed pursuant to this Bylaw, or who destroys, pulls down, alters or interferes with any work carried out or thing done under the authority of this Bylaw and any such resolution, shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties prescribed by the General Penalty Bylaw.
- 4. Bylaw No 106 is hereby repealed.
