

BYLAW NO. 226 / 19

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MARTIN NO 122

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Martin No 122, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw";
- 2. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Martin No 122;
- 3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the Municipality for which no other penalty is provided;
- 4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the Municipality is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction:

 a) In the case of an individual or a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$5,000, and in the case of continuing offence, to a further fine note exceeding \$2,500 for each day which the offence continues.
- 5. Bylaw No 176/08 is hereby repealed.
