RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MARTIN NO 122

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR
CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS**


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Martin No 122, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw";
2. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Martin No 122;
3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the Municipality for which no other penalty is provided;
4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the Municipality is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction:
 - a) In the case of an individual or a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$5,000, and in the case of continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day which the offence continues.
5. Bylaw No 176/08 is hereby repealed.
